## Terms and conditions of membership

*This document outlines the requirements for membership, current as at January 2017*

1. **Committee of Management:** The members of the Management committee will be selected by members vote and will stand for two years
2. **Ethical Code:** In the interests of transparency, the ethical code to which all practitioners must adhere is published on the website at [www.bbrs.org.uk](http://www.bbrs.org.uk) for visitors to peruse.
3. **Mentoring (a):** Adequate Mentoring is mandatory for continued registration. This is to ensure that all members maintain a professional level of expertise. A minimum of six Mentoring sessions annually is required, 3 of which are online and included in the Annual Registration fee (See **Registration** below.)
4. **Mentoring (b):** Mentoring must be with an appointed Mentor or Trainer of the association to which a member belongs. Online Mentoring will normally be in groups, though personal supervision can be requested if necessary. The groups will be of a minimum forty-five minutes duration and limited in numbers. The online sessions included as part of the Registration Fee will be available in 3 different time zones. Any updates to technique will be discussed at this time.
5. **Registration:** As from January 1, 2017, there will be an Annual Registration Fee of £100.00 that includes three online group Mentoring sessions throughout the year.
6. **Websites and Promotion:** Member may display the 'Registered Practitioner' seal on their website and other promotional material.
7. Practitioners must ensure that all content descriptive of therapy on their websites and other promotional material complies with the laws concerning advertising in their country.
8. **Practitioner Levels:** These are dependent upon (a) the level of general experience in practice; and (b) the length of time as a member of The Society. The memberships grades, in order, are: **Associate Member, Practitioner Member, Advanced Member, Accredited Member**. There is also a **Fellow** grade though this is awarded for special services to The Society and the profession.
